County represented at Clean Vehicle Technology Expo

The San Bernardino County Department of Public Works will have four of its clean-air vehicles on display at the Southern California Clean Vehicle Technology Expo located at the Ontario Convention Center on October 17th.

The vehicles will be on display at the Expo from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Wednesday the 17th as part of the outside Ride and Drive display. They all run on LNG (natural gas) alternative fuel. The four vehicles are an International 7600 three-axle water truck, a Freight Condor three-axle dump body, an Auto Car WX42 two-axle dump truck, and an American La France Condor two-axle asphalt patch truck. This is an opportunity for the public to see these working vehicles up close.

The Expo brings together Southern California's fleet operators, alternative/clean fuel vehicle and infrastructure technology providers, funding agencies, and other industry experts to share information on alternative/clean fuel vehicle funding, policies and regulations.

The Expo utilizes a format that maximizes the interaction between the public and private fleet operators, technology manufacturers, fuel suppliers and infrastructure providers.

These vehicles produce a fraction of the emissions generated by conventional diesel and gasoline engines and are a component of the County's commitment to providing a cleaner environment for its citizens.
