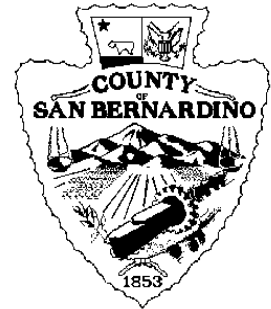

Loma Linda Branch Library Remodels

The County Library is announcing the re-dedication and open house of the Loma Linda Branch Library Tuesday, May 24 at 3:30 p.m. and wishes to invite the public. Third District Supervisor Dennis Hansberger, Council Member Robert Ziprick and County Librarian Ed Kieczkowski will be on hand to welcome visitors and cut the ribbon.

The most noticeable change brought about by the remodel is the removal of a wall separating the library from an adjoining meeting room. This opened up an additional 500 sq. ft. of floor space which was used to create a new, 500 sq. ft. Children's Area. This area, which features additional shelving, new tables and chairs and a new décor, will be the scene of the library's summer programs for children.

The remodel also included new carpet and paint throughout the building, a new Friends of the Library bookstore, new lounge furniture and the addition of a six-station computer work area. Both the Reference and Young Adult areas have been reconfigured and 450 linear feet of shelving has been added. The branch is located at 25581 Barton Road and light refreshments will be served.
