San Timoteo Canyon Creek Flood Control Trail

San Bernardino County Department of Public Works Flood Control District is advising residents of the Redlands area that the maintenance access road along the north side of the San Timoteo basins east of San Timoteo Canyon Road is not a public trail as was previously shown on the Redlands Conservancy trail website.

Ongoing maintenance makes this area potentially hazardous to hikers. The San Bernardino County Flood Control District has posted "No Trespassing" signs in this area.

The Flood Control District is reaching out to the City of Redlands and the Redlands Conservancy to assist in accommodating them if they choose to develop a trail agreement in this area. This process was used to establish the trail agreement with the City of Loma Linda and the District for the section of trail that is in the City of Loma Linda. Public Works is recommending that the public utilize the designated trail along San Timoteo Channel between Redlands Boulevard and Barton Road within the City of Loma Linda.
