Learn all there is to do for fun in your own backyard at the At Your Service Community Resource Fair

San Bernardino, Calif. – Looking for something fun to do? San Bernardino County has thousands of entertainment options and their all in your backyard.

In a region larger than some states, there is no need for a dull moment San Bernardino County. Find some of the best terrain for snow sports in the local mountains. Stroll some of the most creative shopping experiences in Southern California. Enjoy sports? The county has venues to watch nearly every sport imaginable and places where you can participate if watching is not your thing.

But where can you learn about all the entertainment options available in one place?

Come to the County of San Bernardino's first **At Your Service Community Resource Fair**, from **9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Thursday, March 25 at Victoria Gardens**, 12505 North Main Street, in Rancho Cucamonga. The County's Department of Economic Development will have 40 booths highlighting the attractions that make San Bernardino County the best place for recreation in Southern California.

See a WWII P38 fighter plane display and learn about all that the County's airports have to offer, including the Planes of Fame Air Show, May 16 and 17 at the Chino Airport and the Apple Valley Air Show October 3. While visiting the booth, learn about the employment, recreational and business opportunities the airports have to offer and listen to a variety of speakers, including the world famous aerobatic pilot Mike Mangold.

See the way life was in San Bernardino County at the County Museum's booth where staff members will show how people worked and played in the 1580s and 1880s.

Representatives from the County's mountain resorts and communities will have information on the year-round fun available at the higher elevations.

For those with the need for speed, representatives from the Auto Club Speedway will be on hand to promote the events at the world famous venue. Visitors can also check out a classic Woody station wagon, a NASCAR pace car and super bikes to promote the Suzuki AMA Pro Superbike Challenge on March 26, 27 and 28 at the speedway.

With Spring in the air, that can mean only one thing: baseball. The county has two minor league teams to choose from. Come to the **At Your Service** Fair and learn more about the San Bernardino 66ers and the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes, ticket packages and special promotions.

Want something more cerebral, the County hosts the Big Bear and Arrowhead film festivals and is home to the California Theater of the Performing Arts, Tibbies Center Stage Theatre in Fontana, the San Bernardino Symphony and the Huck Finn Jubilee.

Several department will have free games, demonstrations, entertainment and information on the services they provide – all with the purpose of letting residents know how to best use the County's services.
