If you need **to report a stray, injured, or deceased animal**, please contact the Animal Care & Control at **1-800-472-5609**.

Animal Care & Control is also strongly recommending that pet owners that are in voluntary evacuation areas plan on taking their animals with them. Please do not wait! Evacuate as early as possible. Contact family and friends who may be able to temporarily house you and your animals. If you are unable to evacuate your animals you can contact Animal Care & Control at 1-800-472-5609, but please be advised that officers may not be able to respond immediately due to the extremely high level of calls. Officers will do their very best to help you and your pets, but ultimately it is up to you to plan for their evacuation and safety.
