Residents invited to meeting on draft windmill ordinance

The County of San Bernardino Land Use Services Department will host a public meeting Friday night in Hesperia to provide interested residents with information about the county's draft windmill ordinance and record any comments or concerns on the matter.

The meeting will be held on Friday, June 3, 2005, at 7 p.m., at the Rick Novack Center, 13558 Palm St., Hesperia.

The county's Land Use Services Department plans on June 9 to ask the county Planning Commission to endorse proposed amendments to current regulations on accessory wind energy systems. The ordinance would eventually have to be publicly heard and approved by the Board of Supervisors before taking effect.

The proposed new ordinance is intended to provide a uniform and comprehensive set of standards, conditions, and procedures for the placement of these systems in the unincorporated areas of San Bernardino County. The draft ordinance is also designed to ensure that such systems are designed and located in a manner that minimizes visual and safety impacts on the surrounding community.

The county encourages anyone interested in this subject to attend Friday's public meeting.
