Early Identification and Intervention Services

Children will be referred to this service if they are experiencing similar difficulties as those served by SART, but in a less severe manner. Services will be provided by clinicians and rehabilitation specialists. Children do NOT need to have Medi-Cal to be served at EIIS centers.

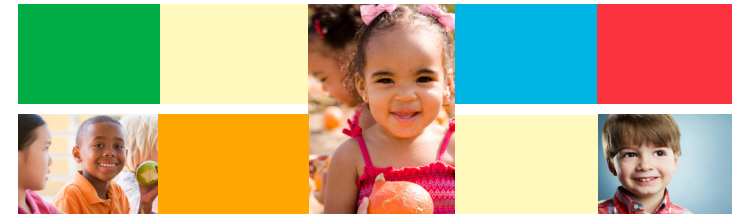

EIIS

Early Identification and Intervention Services



Two programs designed to provide comprehensive services to high-risk children ages 0-5.

Presenting problems may include:

- ⦿ Aggressive Behavior
- ⦿ Speech Problems
- ⦿ Short Attention Span
- ⦿ Prenatal Exposure to Drugs and/or Alcohol
- ⦿ Infants that are difficult to comfort
- ⦿ Sleep difficulties
- ⦿ Excessive tantrums

What to Expect

When a child is struggling with a learning, behavioral or emotional problem, accurate and complete evaluation is necessary in order to make a difference in his/her life.

Necessary interventions will be put in place to help facilitate optimal development.

Parents and caregivers will be given the support and guidance that they need to promote a continuum of care at home and in school.

Getting Started

You may be referred for services to SART or EIIS through Children and Family Services, Preschool Services, your pediatrician, or you may self-refer to the center nearest you.

Services are covered through combined funding between Medi-Cal, MHSA, and First 5 San Bernardino.

Screening

Your child will be screened by administering the Ages and Stages Questionnaire (ASQ) and the ASQ Social Emotional to evaluate his/her current functioning.

Assessment

Assessment will be provided by members of a transdisciplinary team and may include: clinicians, psychologists, pediatricians, speech/language therapists and occupational therapists.

Referral

Based upon the results of the screening and assessment, the transdisciplinary team will provide the caregiver with treatment recommendations and appropriate referrals.

Treatment may include:

- ⦿ PCIT (Parent Child Interactive Therapy)
- ⦿ Play Therapy
- ⦿ Occupational Therapy
- ⦿ Speech and Language Therapy
- ⦿ Dyad Therapy Linkage
- ⦿ Medication Support
