RESOLUTION NO. 3255

A RESOLUTION OF THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION FOR SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY ORDERING LAFCO 3220 – REORGANIZATION TO INCLUDE ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF CHINO AND DETACHMENT FROM COUNTY SERVICE AREAS 70 & SL-1 (PIPELINE ISLAND)

WHEREAS, this action is being taken pursuant to the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000 (Government Code Sections 56000 et seq.); and,

WHEREAS, the public hearing by the Local Agency Formation Commission for San Bernardino County (hereafter "the Commission") was called for October 18, 2017 at the time and place for which notice was given, and at the hearing the Commission heard and received all oral and written support and/or opposition; the Commission considered all plans and proposed changes of organization, and all evidence which were made, presented, or filed; it received evidence as to whether the territory is inhabited or uninhabited, improved or unimproved; and all persons present were given an opportunity to hear and be heard in respect to any matter relating to the application, in evidence presented at the hearing;

WHEREAS, the primary reason for this reorganization is to provide municipal services within logical service boundaries; and,

WHEREAS, on October 18, 2017, the Commission, as CEQA lead agency, determined that this proposal is statutorily exempt from environmental review. The basis for this determination is that this reorganization is a ministerial action, required by the terms of Governmental Code Section 56375(a)(4). Without discretion in the Commission's consideration of this proposal, approval of this proposal is exempt from environmental review pursuant to Section 15268 of the State CEQA Guidelines. The Commission adopted the Statutory Exemption and directed its Executive Officer to file a Notice of Exemption within five days; and,

WHEREAS, at the hearing, the Commission made the findings, pursuant to Government Code Section 56375.3, that the reorganization territory:

 does not exceed 150 acres in area and that the area constitutes the entirety of the island;

- is substantially surrounded by the City of Chino;
- is substantially developed or developing based upon the existence of public utilities within the area, the presence of public improvements, and the presence of physical improvements within the area;
- does not contain prime agricultural lands as defined by Section 56064; and,
- will benefit from the availability and extension of municipal services from the City
 of Chino and is already benefitting from the receipt of water service from the City
 while a parcel within the reorganization area is also benefitting from the receipt of
 sewer service from the City.

Therefore, the Commission waived the protest proceedings.

WHEREAS, the Commission adopted its Resolution No. 3251 on October 18, 2017 making determinations and approving the proposed reorganization as described in Exhibit "A" and "A-1" attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein; and,

WHEREAS, the terms and conditions for LAFCO 3220, as approved by the Commission, on October 18, 2017, are as follows:

CONDITIONS:

<u>Condition No. 1.</u> The boundaries are approved as set forth in Exhibits "A" and "A-1" attached.

<u>Condition No. 2.</u> The following distinctive short-form designation shall be used throughout this proceeding: LAFCO 3220.

<u>Condition No. 3.</u> All previously authorized charges, fees, assessments, and/or taxes currently in effect by the City of Chino (annexing agency) shall be assumed by the annexing territory in the same manner as provided in the original authorization pursuant to Government Code Section 56886(t).

<u>Condition No. 4.</u> The City of Chino shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the Local Agency Formation Commission for San Bernardino County from any legal expense, legal action, or judgment arising out of the Commission's approval of this proposal, including any reimbursement of legal fees and costs incurred by the Commission.

<u>Condition No. 5.</u> Pursuant to Government Code Section 56886.1, public utilities, as defined in Section 216 of the Public Utilities Code, have ninety (90) days following the recording of the Certificate of Completion to make the necessary changes to impacted utility customer accounts.

RESOLUTION NO. 3255

<u>Condition No. 6.</u> The date of issuance of the Certificate of Completion shall be the effective date of this reorganization.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Officer hereby determines and orders as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Government Code Section 56375.3, the protest proceedings for this action have been waived as outlined above.

SECTION 2. The Executive Officer, on behalf of the Commission, hereby orders the reorganization as described in Exhibits "A" and "A-1" to include the annexation to the City of Chino.

SECTION 3. The regular County assessment roll is utilized by the City of Chino.

SECTION 4. The affected territory will not be taxed for existing general bonded indebtedness and/or contractual obligations of the annexing agency, the City of Chino.

SECTION 5. The Executive Officer shall cause to be prepared and filed a Certificate of Completion, as required by Government Code Sections 57176 through 57203, and a Statement of Boundary Change, as required by Government Code Section 57204.
