The City of San Bernardino submitted a request for authorization of the out-of-agency wastewater service for Assessor Parcel Numbers (APNs) 0265-272-04, 0268-031-11, and 0268-211-22 located in various areas within the City of San Bernardino's sphere of influence, and for APN 0164-202-49 located within the City of Colton.

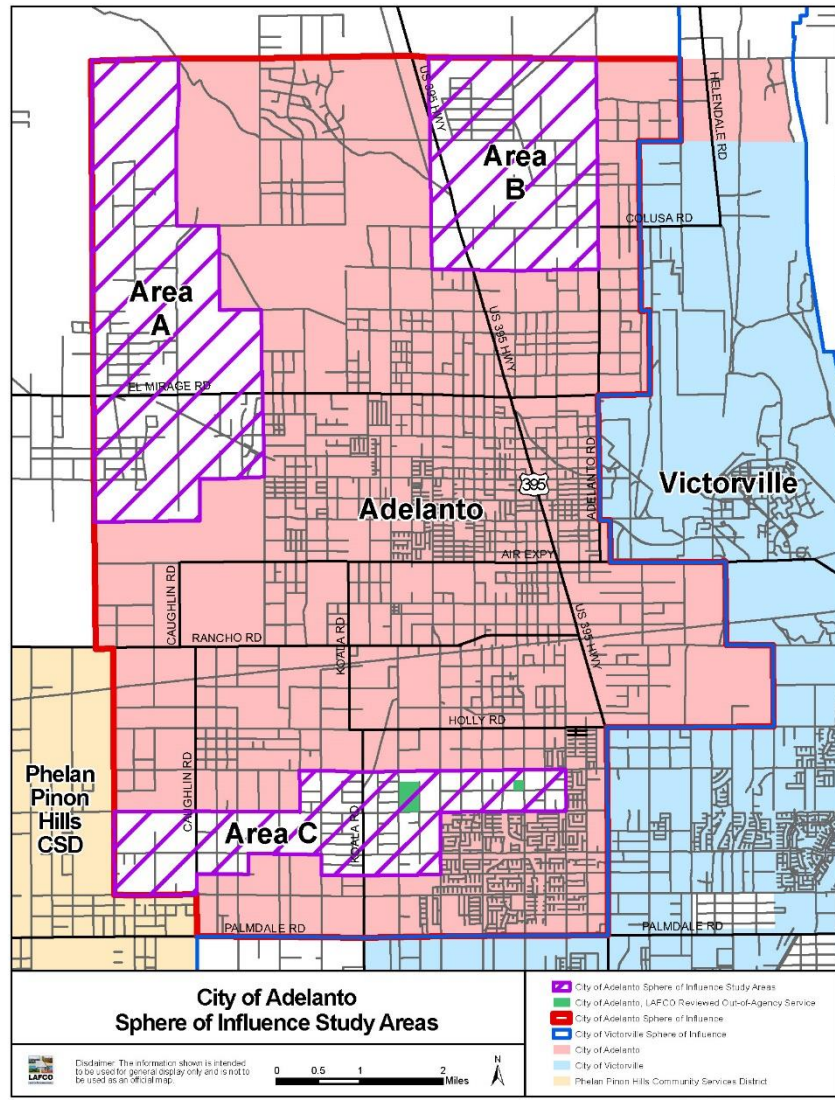

The City is in the southwestern portion of the Mojave Desert, north of the San Gabriel Mountains, approximately 40 miles north of the City of San Bernardino. The City is bisected by U.S. Highway 395, generally located northwest of the City of Victorville.

As part of its Countywide Service Review for Wastewater, LAFCO, at its August 15, 2018 hearing, initiated a sphere of influence amendment for the City of Adelanto to determine the appropriate sphere of influence for the City. Currently, the City has three distinct sphere of influence areas located outside its corporate boundaries:

- Area "A", encompassing approximately 5,372 acres and is located near the northwest portion of the City;
- Area "B", contains approximately 3,291 acres and is located near the northeast area of the City along U.S. Highway 395; and,
- Area "C", comprises approximately 2,939 acres and is located in the southern portion of the City.

Combined, the total acreage of the three unincorporated sphere of influence areas is 11,602 acres.
