LAFCO 3186 – REORGANIZATION TO INCLUDE DISSOLUTION OF
CREST FOREST FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT AND ITS SERVICE ZONES
PM-A AND PM-1 ANNEXATION TO THE SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY FIRE
PROTECTION DISTRICT, ITS MOUNTAIN SERVICE ZONE AND SERVICE ZONE
PM-1 AND FORMATION OF SERVICE ZONE PM-4 OF SAN BERNARDINO
COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

Notice is hereby given that a Protest Hearing will be held by the Executive Officer of the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) for San Bernardino County. The hearing will be held at the WIB Meeting Room at 215 N. "D" St., 2nd Floor, San Bernardino, California 92415-0490, on **May 21, 2015 at 1:00 p.m.**, to hear and receive any oral or written protests, objections, or evidence which are made, presented, or filed regarding LAFCO 3186.

The study area for LAFCO 3186 encompasses approximately 18 square miles generally bordered by section lines along Crest Summit and the community of Blue Jay on the east; a combination of parcel lines generally along Rim of the World Highway (Hwy 18) and the community of Rimforest on the south; a combination of section lines and parcel lines generally along Playground Drive, Ridge Drive, and Sawpit Canyon Trail on the west; and a combination of section lines and parcels lines south of Silverwood Lake, Miller Canyon, and Pilot Rock on the north. The area includes Lake Gregory and the unincorporated areas commonly known as Skyland, Crestline, Valley of Enchantment, Valley View Park, Cedarpines Park, Arrowhead Highlands, Twin Peaks, Crest Park, Rimforest, and Blue Jay.

The reorganization annexation area is shown on the map available for review in the LAFCO office, located at 215 N. "D" Street, Suite 204, San Bernardino, CA 92415-0490, and on our website:

The Crest Forest Fire Protection District initiated the reorganization proposal by adoption of a resolution of application. The reason for this proposal, as outlined by the Crest Forest Fire Protection District, is to:

- (1) Provide for a simplification of government structure to eliminate the duplication of administrative services currently provided by the contract for service implemented in July of 2013;
- (2) Reduce the cost of providing fire protection, ambulance, and other related services within the territory of the former Crest Forest Fire Protection District; and,
- (3) Provide the general public with a clearer understanding of the fire operations in the Crest Forest community.

The proposed terms and conditions for this reorganization are set forth in LAFCO Resolution No. 3196 adopted by the Commission on March 18, 2015, which is available for review in the LAFCO office, and on our website:

How to file a Protest: Any registered voter or owner of land within the territory proposed to be reorganized may file an official protest. Such protest must be made in writing and submitted to the LAFCO office prior to the conclusion of the Protest Hearing. The written protest must be signed and dated. Any protest without a date, bearing a date prior to the date of publication of this notice, or submitted after the conclusion of the hearing, shall be disregarded for purposes of ascertaining the value of any written protests. Protest cannot be accepted by fax or email.

Protest submitted for a landowner must contain the address of the land owned within the proposal and the Assessor Parcel Number (APN). Protest submitted for a registered voter must include the name of the voter, signature and address as they appear on the affidavit of registration.
