## PROP 115

I. Understanding what proposition 115 is and how it pertains to law enforcement.

## LEARNING NEED:

A peace officer must have the proper understanding of our current propositions and laws to properly perform the duties of a law enforcement officer.

- A. Proposition 115:
  - 1. Proposition 115 is known as the "Crime Victim's Justice Reform Act"
  - 2. It allows the officer to testify at the preliminary hearing.
    - a. Officer can testify as to statements by victims/ witnesses during the investigation
  - 3. Allows DA's to overcome hearsay objections.
    - a. Hearsay is normally thrown out of court
  - 4. Prop 115 makes it so victims do not have to appear and testify against the criminal twice.
  - 5. Only a District attorney or a defendant may use
- A. Proposition 115 is covered in California Penal Code 872(b)
  - 1. Officers should not read from their report in court.
- B. Recruits will understand the terminology and the court procedures
  - 1. Officers will be asked in court if they are Prop 115 certified
  - 2. Officers will be able to testify that they received two hours of training
  - 3. Officers will receive a Prop 115 identification card certifying their training.
- C. What officers will need to say and do to perform well in court.
