FREE AWARENESS AND SCREENING EVENT



Cancer is the second-leading cause of mortality in the United States. During 2012, it is estimated that 14,875 Riverside and San Bernardino County residents will hear the words, "You have cancer." This event is designed to raise awareness about cancer and help to prevent it.
