


Dog Behavior Facts

- 1) Never look directly into the eyes of a strange dog. In dog language, this is considered a challenge to fight.
- 2) A wagging tail is NOT always a sign of friendliness. Often, a nervous, shy dog wags his tail.
- 3) Most dogs are very protective of whatever they consider to be their property. Be wary of approaching a dog in a car or a dog in someone's yard.
- 4) The area surrounding a dog's head is considered, by dogs, to be very personal. Do not put your hand up over the head of a dog you do not know — you may be asking to be bit.
- 5) Always have a dog sniff you first. Offer your hand, in a closed fist, at nose level for sniffing. Scent is a dog's way of "reading" about you.
