All dogs in the unincorporated area of San Bernardino County and the contract cities of Big Bear Lake and Yucaipa are required by law to be vaccinated and licensed at four (4) months of age. (California Health and Safety Code Section 121690 and San Bernardino County Ordinance No. 1764, Sections 32.027 and 32.029).

**Make Sure Your Dog Is Currently Vaccinated**

If your dog is not currently vaccinated against rabies, have your dog vaccinated. When your dog is vaccinated be sure to ask your veterinarian to write the date the vaccination will expire on the vaccination certificate. You will need to save this certificate for future reference and send a copy of the certificate with this application form.

Rabies vaccinations are good for three (3) years for an adult dog (over 12 months of age) and one (1) year for a puppy (under 12 months of age).

<b>Regular Unaltered – Medically Determined</b> Your veterinarian has determined that your dog cannot be spayed or neutered. <b>To qualify, written documentation from a veterinarian is required.</b>	\$24.00	\$48.00	\$72.00
<b>Altered</b> – Dog is spayed or neutered. (Spay/Neuter Certificate required).	\$24.00	\$42.00	\$54.00
<b>Senior Citizen</b> – Dog is spayed or neutered. (Spay/Neuter Certificate and proof of owner's age required).	\$12.00	\$24.00	\$36.00
<b>Disabled Citizen</b> – Dog is spayed or neutered and owner is permanently disabled. (Spay/Neuter Certificate and proof of owner's permanent disability required).	\$12.00	\$24.00	\$36.00

**A \$20.00 penalty fee will be assessed on all unlicensed dogs if the dog is five (5) months of age or older and has been owned for more than fifteen (15) days. A \$20.00 penalty fee will be assessed on all licenses, which have been renewed 30 days after the expiration of a current license.**

- If applying for a discounted license, include copies of the Spay/Neuter certificate, a document verifying proof of age (65 years or older), or a doctors statement of owner's permanent disability.
