


# SOME SUN IS GOOD. TOO MUCH IS BAD.




IF YOUR PET IS IN THE SUN, ALWAYS PROVIDE SOME SHADE.


SUN IS FUN, BUT TOO MUCH CAN OVERHEAT AND KILL AN ANIMAL.

AQUARIUM IN STRONG SUNLIGHT.




DOGS AND CATS

SUNNY DAYS.




REPTILES LOVE AND NEED SUNSHINE BUT
