Please be advised that the County of San Bernardino, Department of Public Health, Division of Environmental Health, LEA received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) amendment to the Transfer Processing Report (TPR) for the Twentynine Palms Transfer Station. The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County of San Bernardino, including all active and closed landfills.

Description of Project and LEA's Preliminary Determination

The Twentynine Palms Transfer Station is located at 7501 Pinto Mountain Road. On May 22, 2014, the LEA received from San Bernardino County Solid Waste Management Division, a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) application package to amend the TPR and update said TPR according to the LEA findings in the 5-year Permit Review Report dated March 19, 2014. These changes include:

- Page i, Preface, Advance Planning correspondence location corrected.
- Page II, Table of Contents, Special Waste Handling section deleted, sections numbers updated.
- Page III, Table of Contents, Table 2 page updated and Figure 3.1 deleted.
- Page 4, Section 2.1.2, Figure 3 revised to reflect current UE- Waste storage area and baler location.
- Page 5, Section 2.1.2, Removed reference to bay one.
- Page 6, Section 2.1.3, Revised to change Salvaging to Scavenging.
- Page 11, Section 2.6, Trailer capacity corrected.
- Page 16, Section 3.1.7, Hazardous waste storage information and footnote revised.
- Page 18, Section 3.2.4, Statement regarding facility location revised.
- Page 27, Index and cross reference of Regulatory Codes revised.
- Load Checking as discussed with Juan Espinoza, deposition of prohibited waste found in the waste stream will be included in future Hazardous Waste Load checking Program reports.
- Vector Inspection control Program, as discussed with Juan Espinoza, results of the vector inspection/ control program will be included in future quarterly LEA reports.

The LEA finds that the proposed changes are consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted CEQA documents, are consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current solid waste facilities permit. The LEA approved the amendment on June 19, 2014.
