Please be advised that the County of San Bernardino, Department of Public Health, and Division of Environmental Health (LEA) received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) amendment to the Transfer Processing Report (TPR) for the Heap's Peak Transfer Station. The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County of San Bernardino, including all active and closed landfills.

Description of Project and LEA's Preliminary Determination

The Heap's Peak Transfer Station is located in the County of San Bernardino on the north side of State Highway 18, Running Springs, CA 92382. On July 11, 2014 the LEA received, from San Bernardino County Solid Waste Management Division, a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) application package to amend the TPR and update said TPR according to the LEA findings in the 5-year Permit Review Report dated March 19, 2014. These changes include:

- Page I to v, Table of Contents, Updated numbering and Appendix B title.
- Page 2-8, Section 2.5.3 Table updated.
- Tables, Table 1 updated.
- Appendix G, Operating Permits updated.
- Page 3-7, Figure 3.2 revised to identify current E-Waste storage location.
- Page 5-1, 5-2, 5-3, Index and Cross Reference of Regulatory Codes updated.
- Appendix B, Site Owner Manager resume updated.

The LEA finds that the proposed change is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted CEQA documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current solid waste facilities permit. The LEA approved the amendment on July 23, 2014.
