Please be advised that the County of San Bernardino, Department of Public Health, and Division of Environmental Health (LEA) received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) amendment to the Transfer Processing Report (TPR) for the Inland Regional Material Recovery Facility & Transfer Station. The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County of San Bernardino, including all active and closed landfills.

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Description of Project and LEA's Preliminary Determination

The Inland Regional Material Recovery Facility & Transfer Station is located at 2059 East Steel Road Colton, CA 92324. On December 12, 2014 the LEA received, from Inland Regional Material Recovery Facility & Transfer Station, a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) application package to amend the TPR as requested during the 5 Year Permit Review. The changes include:

- Elevated Trapping Station added to facility plan
- Language added to TPR to reflect facility operations
- Table of Contents.

The LEA finds that the proposed change is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted CEQA Documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current solid waste facilities permit. The LEA approved the amendment on December 16, 2014.
