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Please be advised that the County of San Bernardino, Department of Public Health, Division of Environmental Health (LEA) received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) amendment to the Joint Technical Document (JTD) for Mid-Valley Sanitary Landfill. The LEA is certified by the California's Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County of San Bernardino, including all active and closed landfills.

## Mid-Valley Sanitary Landfill Amendment Public Notice

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#### Description of Project and LEA's Preliminary Determination

The Mid-Valley Sanitary Landfill is located at 2390 N. Alder Ave, Rialto .On January 27, 2015 the LEA received, from Mid-Valley Sanitary Landfill, a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) application package to amend the JTD to make general updates and changes as a result of the 5 year permit review. The changes include:

- Non-water release corrective action cost estimate, site life closure cost estimate, postclosure maintenance cost estimate.

The LEA finds that the proposed change is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted CEQA documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current solid waste facilities permit. The LEA approved the amendment on February 20, 2015.
