As a property owner, tenant, or person who has requested notice, please be advised that the County of San Bernardino Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received, and is considering an application to modify the solid waste facility permit (SWFP) for the U.S.M.C. 29 Palms Disposal Facility. The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County of San Bernardino, including all active and closed landfills.

Description of Project and LEA's Preliminary Determination

The U.S.M.C. 29 Palms Disposal Facility is a municipal solid waste disposal site that operates under the Solid Waste Facility Permit Number 36-AA-0067 and is located at Marine Air Ground Task Force Training Command, Landfill Road, Twentynine Palms, CA 92278.

On August 12, 2014 the LEA accepted for review, the permit application package from U.S.M.C. 29 Palms Disposal Facility requesting to change the total permitted area of 128.5 acres to 127.6 acres due to a reduction in the proposed Material Recovery Facility (MRF) area and to amend language in the JTD. The permitted disposal area of 69 acres remains the same. No other changes to the Solid Waste Facility Permit are under consideration at this time.

The LEA finds that the proposed change is a non-material change pursuant to Title 27 §21665 and qualifies as a permit modification. The LEA's preliminary determination is that the proposed permit modification be approved.

The decision to approve or deny the SWFP modification will be made by the LEA within 120 days of the date the application was deemed complete as required by State statute, and will be submitted to the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB) for concurrence.
