Inspection found:

Adult Fannia fly population heavy to moderate at time of inspection.

Observed Adulthood ULV fog application during inspection, which did drop population to moderate.

Pesticide log recorded daily adulticide applications. Also Neporex IGR applications to all conventional houses within last two weeks.

No active watering system leaks. Lime applied liberally throughout houses.

Observed Fannia larva all stages and high concentration of Fannia eggs in houses 4-9 and 11-12.

Areas under dropping boards outside and between houses need to be clean out.

Back staging area needs to be scraped clean.

Neporex IGR application needs to be reapplied as soon as label allows. Please pay close attention to areas between drier base and new manure growth or wet manure. Heaviest activity found within 2 inches from top crust.

No violations observed at this time.
