Description: Dead poultry shall be removed from the cages at least once a day and immediately disposed of by one of the following methods:

- (A) Placed in a fly-tight container or structure for proper off-site removal and removed from the premises at least weekly. Containers shall be kept clean to prevent fly breeding.
- (B) Placed in a disposal pit of approved construction.

40K080 Maintenance - Drying Manure

Description: Structures and equipment for both ground and cage operations shall be constructed so as to facilitate the drying and removal of manure when required, and shall provide drainage of moisture away from all manure.

Violation Description: It shall be unlawful for any person or entity to create or allow the existence of a public nuisance as defined in this Article. 33.0902
 Definitions:

PUBLIC NUISANCE. For the purposes of this Article means any of the following:

(1) (A) Any breeding place for mosquitoes, flies, rats, or other vectors of public health importance which exists by reason of any use made of the land on which it is found, or of any artificial change in its natural condition. Presence of immature arthropods of public health importance shall constitute prima facie evidence that a place is a breeding place for arthropods. The presence of rodent droppings, trails, or evidence of feeding activity, shall constitute prima facie evidence that a place is a breeding place for rats.

(2) Water which is a breeding place for mosquitoes, flies, or other arthropods of public health importance.

VECTOR. Any animal capable of transmitting the causative agent of human disease or capable of producing human discomfort or injury, including, but not limited to, mosquitoes, flies, fleas, ticks, mites, and rats, but not including any domesticated animal.

Overall Inspection Comments

Inspection found adult fly population moderate to heavy on ranch and increasing in community. Complaints have come into Vector Control.
 Heavy larval activity throughout ranch. Breeding between houses, in openings at mid-section perpendicular to rows and heavy, heavy breeding on concrete aprons at end of houses.
 Water system leaks present throughout ranch. Cooling systems are leaking heavily at concrete aprons and running of onto pavement. Pavement also breeding heavily.
 Showed ranch operators areas and instructed to clean off aprons. To remove wet manure and replace with dry.
 Stockpiled manure from clean out is dry and non-fly breeding.
 Dead bird barrels open and full.
 Dead birds in rows between houses. Observed operator mowing between houses with bird carcass.
 Billed inspection.
 Chemical control measures used by Vector Control at this time. Ranch needs continued treatment to gain control.
