Inspector Comments: A non-field response inspection was conducted, via phone call in request of the facility.

The San Bernardino County Environmental Health Services received a message on 11/27/2023, stating they had a fire in the kitchen. Upon questioning, the person in charge (PIC) stated the broiler caught on fire and only affected the ventilation hood. Per PIC, no food or food contact surfaces were affected by the fire. The PIC stated the facility is currently self-closed and will remain self-closed until approved by the San Bernardino County EHS officials. Upon further questioning, the PIC stated the ANSUL system was set off; However, it has not been recharged, due to damage of the ventilation hood. The PIC stated the facility plans to replace the ventilation hood, grease duct, and exhaust fan.

The PIC was advised to contact the San Bernardino County EHS plan check at 1(800)442-2283 for any remodeling, reconstruction, or addition of new equipment. The PIC was advised to remain self-closed until the San Bernardino County EHS approves the facility to open and operate. Contact 1(800)442-2283 to schedule a date for re-opening and re-inspection.
