Inspector Comments: Observed masseuse wearing a very short skirt and a sleeveless midriff top.

Owner must ensure masseuse shall be dressed in clothing made of an opaque material, and at a minimum, shall not expose the technician's undergarments or bare midriff, or any specified anatomical areas, and shall comply with the following requirements, as applicable:

- (A) All garments covering the upper torso (e.g., shirts or dresses) shall have sleeves not less than two inches in length, measuring from the top of the shoulder, and necklines no lower than two inches below the clavicle.
- (B) Hems of dresses, skirts, smocks, or other similar garments shall not be more than two inches above the top of the knee.
- (C) Cuffs or hems of shorts, culottes, pants or other similar garments shall not be more than six inches above the top of the knee.

Description: Licensees under this Chapter shall insure that all persons employed to work on the massage clinic premises, and including all massage technicians conducting licensed activities on the massage clinic premises, shall be dressed in clothing made of an opaque material, and at a minimum, shall not expose the technician's undergarments or bare midriff, or any specified anatomical areas, and shall comply with the following requirements, as applicable:

- (A) All garments covering the upper torso (e.g., shirts or dresses) shall have sleeves not less than two inches in length, measuring from the top of the shoulder, and necklines no lower than two inches below the clavicle.
- (B) Hems of dresses, skirts, smocks, or other similar garments shall not be more than two inches above the top of the knee.
- (C) Cuffs or hems of shorts, culottes, pants or other similar garments shall not be more than six inches above the top of the knee.
