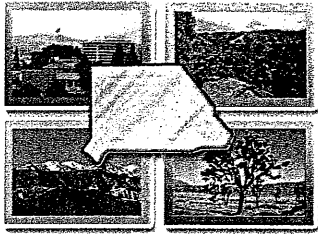

as required by law, and made the following determinations:



Government Code Section 56767 specifies that a landowner  
petition initiating a city annexation must include 5% of the  
assessed value of land. The petition submitted meets the  
threshold, as identified above, having signatures of 100% of the  
landowners owning 100 % of the land value.
