SUBJECT: Agenda Item #6: Continuance of LAFCO 3007 – Dissolution of Parker Dam Recreation and Park District

RECOMMENDATION:

Continue LAFCO 3007 to the August 16, 2006 hearing.

BACKGROUND:

Staff is recommending a continuance since new information discovered during our evaluation warrants further investigation. That information is:

- District files from 2002 recently made available to staff indicate a bank account in the name of the District at a Wells Fargo branch in Parker, Arizona. Staff requests more time to investigate the status and history of this account.
- A review of prior audits showed the existence of a fixed asset identified as an advertisement sign. The former District Coordinator of the District provided staff with a recent photo of the sign advertising the District and identified its location. Previous attempts by staff to locate this asset were unsuccessful. The sign is located outside the District's boundaries at the intersection of State Highway 62 and US Highway 95, commonly known as Vidal Junction. Research of the sign reveals that the District purchased it in 1991 for \$13,920 and paid rent for placement of the sign from 1991 to 1994. Staff requests more time to investigate the status and history of the sign.

For these reasons, staff is recommending a continuance to the August 16, 2006 hearing.
