**SUBJECT: AGENDA ITEM #8 – DISCUSSION OF FACILITATING MEETINGS TO
CLARIFY BOUNDARIES BETWEEN CITIES OF SAN BERNARDINO
AND HIGHLAND**

At the September 18th hearing, Commissioner Hansberger requested that an item be placed on the October Agenda to discuss the facilitation of meetings between the Cities of Highland and San Bernardino regarding their mutual boundaries. Therefore, staff included this item on the agenda for further discussion and direction.

Attached is a map outlining the City boundaries in the area and the existing City of San Bernardino sphere of influence. Any proposal to reorganize the boundaries between the Cities in the East Valley will be a reorganization which will, in the staff view, include detachments from each of the Cities by necessity.

Staff wishes to reiterate its position that it will assist the Cities in pursuit of discussions to clarify the boundaries in the East Valley with the understanding that any such change that would propose a city detachment will require the consent of the detaching city. Any detachment proposed without consent could risk the termination of any proposal submitted for consideration.

Staff will be happy to answer any questions at the hearing and will implement the direction of the Commission in providing assistance to the Cities.
