County Service Area 70 Zone P-18 (Randall Crossing Fontana)

County Service Area 70 P-18 is governed by the County Board of Supervisors. The zone has no direct employees, it operates with personnel and supplies provided by County Service Area 70. The zone was established by the County Board on July 9, 2013 for the purpose of drainage and landscaping. The zone is responsible for maintaining two catch basins, one 12" pipe, and a drainage swale with landscaping. Voters approved an annual service charge of \$600 per parcel with a 2.5% inflationary factor. The 2017-18 per parcel service charge is \$662.29, which is currently levied on 20 parcels.

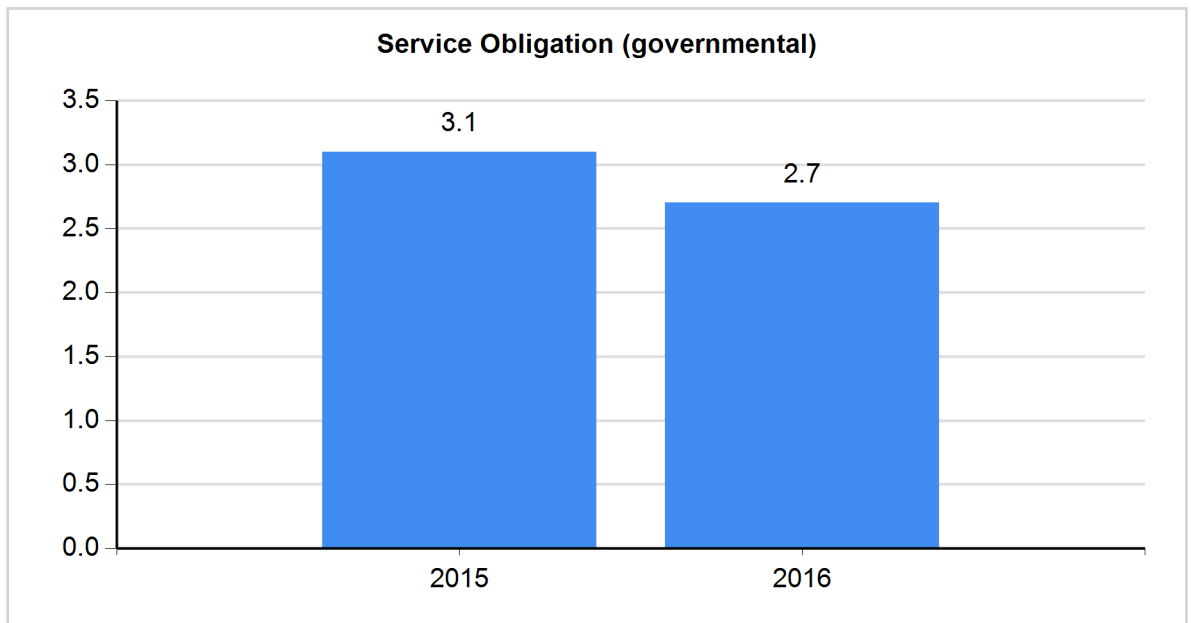
Service Obligation (governmental)
