

County Service Area 70 Zone P-20 (Mulburry Heights)

County Service Area 70 P-20 is governed by the County Board of Supervisors. The zone has no direct employees, it operates with personnel and supplies provided by County Service Area 70. The zone was established by the County Board on January 14, 2014 for the purpose of landscaping and drainage maintenance. The zone is responsible for maintaining 5,285 square feet of landscaping and one 72" corrugated metal perforated pipe. Voters approved an annual service charge of \$1,050 per parcel with a 2.5% inflationary factor. The 2017-18 service charge is \$1,103.16, which is currently levied on 20 parcels.


Service Obligation (governmental)
