### **County Service Area 70 Zone SL-2 (Chino)**

County Service Area 70 SL-2 is governed by the County Board of Supervisors. The zone has no direct employees, it operates with personnel and supplies provided by County Service Area 70. The zone provides streetlight services, funded by a \$122 per parcel service charge, per year with a 1.5% inflationary increase based on requirements and available fund balance which was approved by voters on November 16, 2004. The zone does not receive general levy property tax revenue, therefore assessed value data is not compiled by the County.

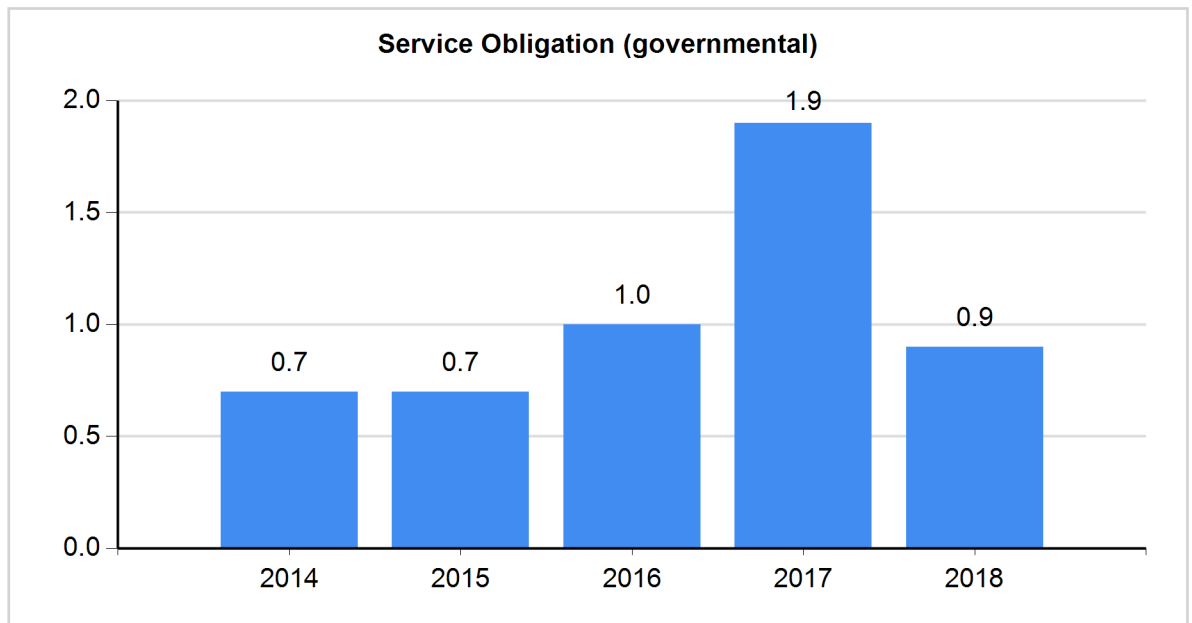
### Service Obligation (governmental)

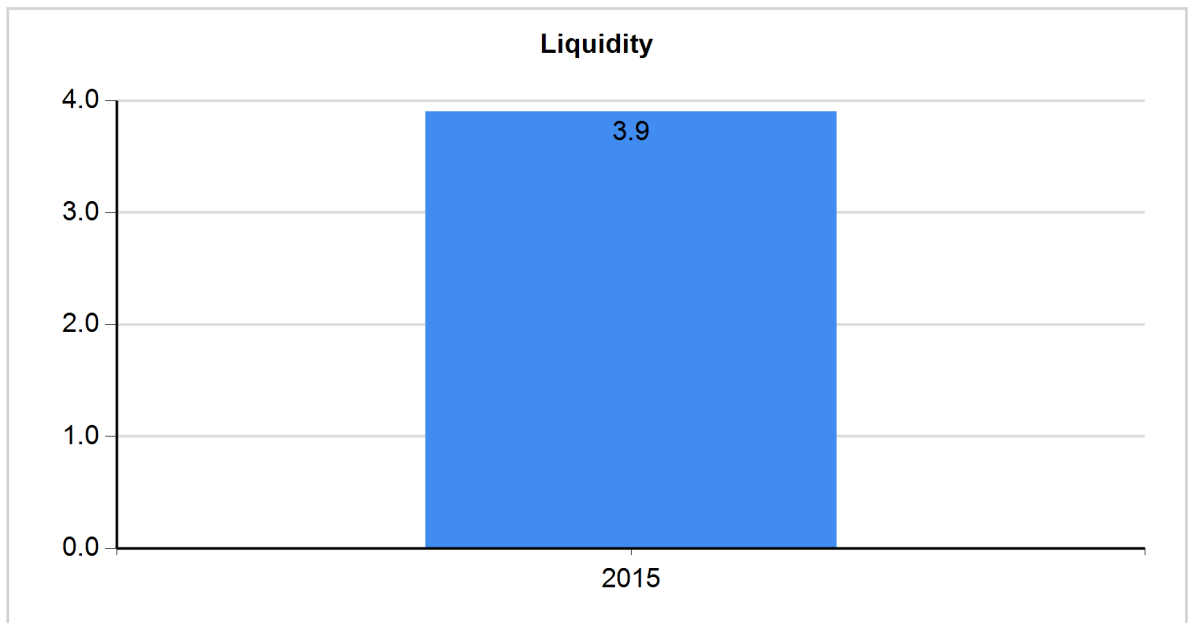
### Liquidity
