



San Bernardino County Fire Protection District - Valley Regional Service Zone

The San Bernardino County Fire Protection District reorganized in July 2008 and created the Valley Regional Service Zone. The zone is a component unit of the San Bernardino County Fire Protection District which is governed by the County Board of Supervisors. The Valley Regional Service Zone provides fire protection and paramedic services to the unincorporated areas of Colton, Devore (Station #2), San Antonio Heights (Station #12), Lytle Creek (Station #20), Mt Baldy (Station #200), Muscoy (Station #75), Bloomington (Station #76), Grand Terrace (Station #23), Mentone (Station #9), Oak Glen (Station #555), Little Mountain, and Highland. Fire protection services are also provided to the Fontana Fire Protection District (Stations #71, #72, #73, #74, #77, #78, and #79) through a service contract. Additionally, within the Valley Regional Service Zone there are two voter approved special tax paramedic service zones which provide services to the communities of Highland and Yucaipa.



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
Change in Assessed Value

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
Property Tax Revenue

Description

This indicator will have more importance for those agencies heavily reliant upon property tax revenues. As this revenue source is relatively stable and lags about two years behind changes in market conditions, this indicator can potentially depict the level of stability of an agency's revenue base.

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
Service Obligation (governmental)

Description

Measures whether or not a government's annual revenues were sufficient to pay for annual operations. A ratio of one or higher indicates that a government lived within its annual revenues.

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
Liquidity

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
Debt Service (governmental)

Description

Looks at service flexibility by determining the amount of total expenditures committed to annual debt service. Service flexibility decreases as more resources are committed to annual debt service.
