SUBJECT: AGENDA ITEM #12 – LAFCO 3144 – ACTIVATION OF FLOOD CONTROL AND PARK AND RECREATION POWERS FOR LAKE ARROWHEAD COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Commission continue consideration of LAFCO 3144 to the September 15, 2010 hearing.

BACKGROUND:

LAFCO 3144 was initiated by resolution of the Lake Arrowhead Community Services District (hereafter shown as LACSD) Board of Directors. The application proposes to activate the latent functions and services of flood control and park and recreation of the LACSD to allow it to begin discussions to assume the responsibilities of County Service Area (CSA) 70 Zone D-1 (Lake Arrowhead Dam). The Certificate of Filing was issued for the proposal following completion of the environmental analysis and the adoption of the property tax transfer resolution by the County. The law requires that the public hearing be held within 90 days of the issuance of the Certificate of Filing, so the matter was scheduled for consideration at the July 21st Hearing.

However, during the processing of the application County Special District and LACSD staffs have been meeting to resolve outstanding issues related to CSA 70 D-1. Supervisor Derry (representing the area) and the LACSD have requested that the item be continued to the September hearing to allow for further discussion and resolution. LAFCO staff recommends approval of the continuance so that the necessary information to provide for a complete analysis of this proposal can be received and ultimately presented to the Commission for its consideration.
