**SUBJECT: AGENDA ITEM #5 ITEMS A THROUGH F – LAFCO 3067(a) through (f) –
CITY OF SAN BERNARDINO ISLANDS**

RECOMMENDATION:

Take LAFCO 3067A through LAFCO 3067F off calendar with instruction to staff to return the matters to the Commission's Agenda as soon as possible following completion of the required revisions to the City of San Bernardino Plan for Service and the LAFCO staff conducted community meetings to review revisions to the areas, and with the requirement for re-advertisement and individual notice of the proposals.

BACKGROUND:

At the February 21, 2007 hearing the Commission modified the boundary of three of the six islands proposed by the City of San Bernardino. At that time, the Commission also divided the application into six separate proposals, LAFCO 2067 A through F. Based upon the expansion of the three islands, the Commission directed staff to conduct its required community outreach for these areas once a revised Plan for Service by the City of San Bernardino was received. The Commission continued the considerations to this hearing.

Staff has outlined the information required for further processing with the City of San Bernardino. However, City of San Bernardino staff has not, to date, provided a position on the Commission's expansion of the three islands nor the updated Plan for Service. Therefore, staff is recommending that the proposals be taken off-calendar rather than be continued from hearing to hearing. It is also recommended that these proposals be required to return at the same hearing as LAFCO 3050 (Arrowhead Springs) is to be considered. In addition, approval of this recommendation will require that when the matter is returned to the Commission for consideration, it will be re-advertised and individual notice will be provided to registered voters and landowners within and surrounding the area.
