**SUBJECT:**   **Agenda Item 10: LAFCO 3024 – Service Review and Sphere of Influence Update for County Service Area 64**

---

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends that the Commission continue LAFCO 3024 to the October 17, 2007 hearing.

**BACKGROUND:**

The position of the Special Districts Department on the municipal service review/sphere update indicated no change to the sphere of influence for County Service Area 64. However, LAFCO staff, with consent of the Special Districts Department staff, proposes to modify the District's sphere of influence to better reflect the City of Victorville and Town of Apple Valley communities based upon the Commission's adopted sphere policies. The modifications proposed are (1) an expansion to the north to encompass territory presently served by the District outside its boundaries, and (2) expansions and reductions to the east to clarify the relationship between the City of Victorville and the Town of Apple Valley community spheres of influence designations.

Staff requests additional time to the process the sphere of influence modifications for the following reasons:

- Special Districts Department has not provided LAFCO staff with written clarification on the types of functions and services currently provided by CSA 64 within its boundaries and response to LAFCO staff's questions regarding property taxes,
- The requested information regarding the appropriation limit for CSA 64 from the Office of the Auditor/Controller-Recorder has not been received, and
- Preparation of the required environmental review is needed.

For these reasons, staff recommends a continuance to the October 17, 2007 hearing.
