SUBJECT: AGENDA ITEM #8 – NOTE RECEIPT OF PROPOSAL INITIATED BY LANDOWNER PETITION – LAFCO 3100 – REORGANIZATION TO INCLUDE ANNEXATIONS TO THE CITY OF VICTORVILLE, VICTORVILLE WATER DISTRICT, VICTORVILLE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT AND VICTORVILLE SANITARY DISTRICT AND DETACHMENT FROM SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT AND ITS NORTH DESERT SERVICE ZONE

State law requires that any proposal involving annexation to a special district that has not been initiated by resolution of the district shall be placed on the next available agenda as an informational item (Government Code Section 56857(a)). Mr. Michael Thies, representing Space Center Mira Loma Inc. the landowner has submitted the petition initiating the reorganization. The purpose of the reorganization is to allow for the delivery of service to a proposed industrial project by the City of Victorville and its related service agencies. The industrial development, approved by the City of Victorville, includes incorporated and unincorporated lands and has a condition of approval requiring the annexation of this property. Maps of the proposed reorganization are included as an attachment to this report.

Government Code Section 56857(a) also sets in motion a 60-day time period in which the affected districts may submit a resolution of opposition to the reorganization. This 60-day period officially began on June 24, 2008 through issuance of the Certificate of Sufficiency for the petition to all affected agencies and will expire on August 22, 2008.

No action is required of the Commission other than to note receipt of the submitted application.
