

NOTICE OF PROTEST HEARING FOR LAFCO 3233 CONTINUED FROM APRIL 30, 2020 TO MAY 14, 2020

LAFCO 3233 – Reorganization to include Dissolution of County Service Area 64 and Formation of the Spring Valley Lake Community Services District together with Formation of Zone A for Solid Waste and Street Sweeping

This notice is to inform you that the Protest Hearing for LAFCO 3233, which has been scheduled for April 30, 2020 at 6:00 p.m., will be continued to May 14, 2020 at 6:00 p.m.

Due to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, the continued Protest Hearing on May 14, 2020 will be conducted virtually by videoconference and teleconference in compliance with the Governor's Executive Order N-29-20. The public may participate in the continued Protest Hearing by:

- Listening to the virtual Protest Hearing by calling **(669) 900-9128** and entering the Meeting ID: **99599577230#**

The public may provide oral protests:

- On the Zoom video conference via the web or the Zoom App, by clicking the 'Raise Hand' button.
- On Zoom via phone, by raising hand by pressing *9.

At the conclusion of the continued Protest Hearing, a determination will be made whether there is sufficient landowner or registered voter written protest submitted to terminate the proposal.

Because the continued Protest Hearing is being conducted virtually, written protests cannot be submitted or presented at the virtual hearing. However, since the Protest Hearing has been continued to May 14, 2020, the protest period has also been extended to May 14, 2020. If you are a landowner or registered voter within LAFCO 3233 and wish to file a written protest, you must:

- Fill-out a Protest Form; and,
- Mail the form to LAFCO at **1170 West 3rd Street, Unit 150, San Bernardino, CA 92415-0490** no later than May 14, 2020. *If mailed protest is postmarked by May 14, 2020 and received by LAFCO by Monday, May 18, 2020, we will process, verify, and count that protest.*

The written protest must be signed and dated during the official protest period, which began on March 31, 2020 and has been extended to May 14, 2020. Any protest without a date, bearing a date prior to March 31, 2020, or postmarked after May 14, 2020, shall be disregarded for purposes of determining the value of any written protests. Protest cannot be accepted by fax or email.
