

# NOTICE OF PROTEST HEARING

## LAFCO 3177 – REORGANIZATION TO INCLUDE CITY OF FONTANA ANNEXATION NO. 173 AND DETACHMENT FROM COUNTY SERVICE AREAS 70 AND SL-1

Notice is hereby given that a Protest Hearing will be held by the Executive Officer of the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) for San Bernardino County. The hearing will be held in the WIB Meeting Room, 215 N. "D" St., 2<sup>nd</sup> Flr., San Bernardino, California 92415-0110, on **September 15, 2014 at 1:30 p.m.**, to hear and receive any oral or written protests, objections, or evidence which are made, presented, or filed regarding LAFCO 3177.

The area of proposed reorganization, encompassing 486+/- acres, is generally bordered by the centerline of the Interstate 10 Freeway on the north; a combination of parcel lines and Almond Avenue on the east (existing City boundaries); parcel lines east and west of Calabash Avenue on the south (existing City boundaries) and Mulberry Avenue on the west (existing City boundaries). The reorganization area is shown on the map available for review in the LAFCO office, located at 215 N. "D" Street, Suite 204, San Bernardino, CA 92415-0490, and on our website:

The City of Fontana initiated the reorganization proposal by adoption of a resolution of application. The reason for this proposal, as outlined by the City of Fontana, is to insure the orderly long range planning and development of the area and to provide for a more effective and efficient delivery of municipal services to residents. The proposal has been assigned the short-form designation of LAFCO 3177. The proposed terms and conditions for this reorganization are set forth in LAFCO Resolution No. 3184 adopted by the Commission on July 16, 2014, which is available for review in the LAFCO office, and on our website:

**How to file a Protest:** Any registered voter or owner of land within the territory proposed to be reorganized may file an official protest. Such protest must be made in writing and submitted to the LAFCO office prior to the conclusion of the Protest Hearing. The written protest must be signed and dated. Any protest without a date, bearing a date prior to the date of publication of this notice, or submitted after the conclusion of the hearing, shall be disregarded for purposes of ascertaining the value of any written protests. Protest cannot be accepted by fax or email.

Protest submitted for a landowner must contain the address of the land owned within the proposal and the Assessor Parcel Number (APN). Protest submitted for a registered voter must include the name of the voter, signature and address as they appear on the affidavit of registration.
