In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the CEQA Guidelines, County Staff prepared a Draft Initial Study / Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) that identify and evaluate the environmental impacts of the Lynx Cat Mountain Quarry and Reclamation Plan proposed mine expansion and reclamation.

Project Title: Lynx Cat Mountain Quarry

Project Location: Approximately 1.25 miles southwest of the intersection of Halstead Road & Black Canyon. Road..

Project Description: Proposal to expand an existing 25 acre vested quarry by 23.2 acres to use as a borrow pit for purposes of providing aggregate and fill material for use during the construction of the State Route 58 Hinkley Expressway Project.
