All materials and activities are included in cost. Camper is NOT enrolled in camp until registration form and full payment are received at the Museum. We cannot "hold" spaces for campers, and space is limited. All sessions are expected to fill.

Due to the activities in these programs, campers must have completed 1st grade and be from 7-10 years of age. Campers must bring a snack and water bottle each day. Shoes must be closed-toe and clothing should be appropriate for physical activities and art making. The Museum staff are not responsible for personal belongings of campers. Camper must exhibit appropriate behavior at the Museum. The camper's medical insurance is the primary source of payment for any accident, injury, or illness arising during Museum camp.

CANCELLATION/CHANGE/REFUND POLICY: Campers may change session based on space availability. Full refund of fees may be made if withdrawal is requested ten (10) days before camp begins. Six (6) to ten (10) days before camp begins, a refund of 75% of the fees may be made. Camp registration payment is nonrefundable five (5) or fewer days prior to camp. The Museum reserves the right to cancel a camp session. In case of cancellation, campers will be notified in advance and full refunds will be made.
