Employment Preparation

Make sure that you meet all education and experience qualifications before applying.

Concentrate your college curriculum in the behavioral science fields, such as Criminal Justice, Psychology, and Sociology.

Learn more about the department by reading The San Bernardino County Probation Department <u>Annual Report</u>.

Study the job description and areas of evaluation on the job announcement.

Think about what kind of general questions would be asked in an interview, based upon the job announcement information.

☐ Volunteer to learn more about the department and job duties, either as a Student Intern or Volunteer in Probation.

Start a physical workout regimen and get good nutrition, so that you can be in the best shape for passing the physical agility test.

During the interview:

- Take your time and calculate your answers
- Be friendly, polite, interested and courteous
- Maintain eye contact with those on the interview panel
- RELAX and just be yourself
