Chair Voni Saxbury called the meeting to order at 6:02 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

3.0 Announcements & Correspondence from the LAMAC: Saxbury shared a letter received from the FAA in response to the letter sent by the MAC. Discussion regarding the content was focused on the lack of communication from the FAA.

4.0 Community Input: Items discussed included the countywide plan.

5.0 Special Presentations:

- a. **Richard Eastman:** Mr. Eastman gave a presentation on the research he has done related to the Air Traffic issue. He discussed multiple topics and took questions from the audience
- b. **Bruce Daniels:** Mr. Daniels gave a presentation related to tourism. The program was designed around trails and tourism.

6.0 Community & Government Updates

ALA: Roberta Rindenow & Wayne Austin; Wayne Austin discussed the new fireboat on Lake Arrowhead, the junior trout rodeo, and launching a new membership database. He encouraged everyone to winterize their boats and docks. He also discussed intake project occurring in North Bay.

Tudor House: Scott Rindenow discussed events at the Tudor House on behalf of John Conner.

SB County Fire: Scott Tuttle updated the community on call volume stats. Gearing up for winter, doing winter ops, training on snow cats. The currently have an urban S&R vehicle at station 91. He discussed new fireboat recently launched on Lake Arrowhead.

Cal Fire: Jeff Veik discussed bark beetles. It is an ongoing problem, specifically in the Crestline area. Doing some significant tree removal that will impact residents and traffic. He recommended you have your chimney cleaned. Prepare your home and your vehicles for winter. We are still in fire season with the possibility of Santa Ana winds. Be vigilant. He shared some statewide fire statistics. There is a significant increase this year over last.

LACCC: Robin Bull shared that the LACCC is working on their marketing application. She also discussed the Governmental Affairs Committee, Blue Jay Parade planning, Taste of Lake Arrowhead (December 6), and upcoming Mixer at Sky Park.

Rim of the World Recreation & Park District: Bob Kinzel gave an update on programs and activities, including Halloween in the park, game of skate, economic development (ATP grant), and basketball program.

ROW Historical Society: Duane Banner discussed recent events including a presentation by Russ Keller at San Moritz, and several other recent events.

CHP: LT. Coronado discussed grant to combat primary collision factors. Some of the problematic areas include speed, crossing over yellow lines, and following too close. He also discussed a recent crash next to Stater Brothers that affected a gas line.
