He discussed the Community Indicators report. He announced that the conditional use permit hearing before the Board of Supervisors regarding Lake Arrowhead Village concerts will be Aug 19. He announced that Sarah Dispenza has resigned from the MAC. The Supervisor's office is accepting applications.

Carol Banner: Lake Arrowhead Communities Chamber of Commerce: Carol reported that the chamber has received positive feedback regarding the delineators on highway 18.

Marc Peebles: Fire Station 91 is currently receiving a facelift including all new windows. This includes new siding, tree removal, and painting the building. Recently there was 3 days of firefighting training out at the Boy Scout Camp in Cedar Glen. Starting to see some bark beetle trees out behind the dam and Cedar Glen. Discussed the importance of preparedness. Residential assessment program is being reinstated. Discussed fire safe council grant for brush clearance in the Cedar Glen area. New radios with more channel capability.
