There will be a parade, picnics, and other activities for the participants. The Skyforest Festival is May 24th.

County Fire: Mark Peebles discussed the Crest Forest Annexation. The last few weeks County Fire has been focusing on wildland season preparation. He also discussed fuel moistures.

USFS: Mark Stamer discussed preparation for fire season. There was a recent small fire in the San Gorgonio wilderness. Last week the USFS held a meeting regarding Grass Valley Fire restoration,

specifically at Tunnel Two ridge. He also discussed a cell tower on the north side of Lake Arrowhead. They originally planned on a mono pole design. They are still accepting comments. Trail nearby is not a forest service trail.
