1.0 Call to Order & Pledge of Allegiance

The meeting was called to order by Chair Voni Saxbury at 6:03 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

2.0 Approval of Minutes

3.0 Community Input: Carol Banner discussed the influx of group homes in the Lake Arrowhead Communities. Brian Hall discussed the possibility of utilizing Papoose Lake for recreation.

4.0 Supervisor's Report:

Murray discussed the proposed rehab project at Camp Komaroff. They are currently drilling a permitted well and doing some tree thinning with an NRCS grant. The Short Term Rental revised ordinance should be coming forward late spring or early summer. Murray discussed the recent Community Plan Update meetings. He encouraged members of the community to attend. The wood shake roof ordinance will take effect July 1, 2016. Next month, there will be a Joint MAC meeting between Lake Arrowhead and Crest Forest. The meeting will be held on April 5, 2016, 6:30 pm, at the San Moritz Lodge. The Sheriff's HOPE team will make a presentation. Cal Trans will also be in attendance.

5.0 Community Updates:

Bill Johnson, Sky Park Santa's Village: They are currently completing a noise study. They have been working with the NRCS on a grant to clear high fire risk areas. There has been some filming occurring on the property. Over 100 volunteers will be planting trees through a program coordinated by Cal Fire. Johnson also discussed the Cal Trans traffic study and the need for widening Hwy 18 and the placement of a signal.

Polly Sauer, Lake Arrowhead Communities Chamber of Commerce: Polly mentioned they have been receiving countless calls regarding the opening of Sky Park. Lake Arrowhead was ranked 3rd on the top 10 most charming towns in Southern California. There have been several other recent magazine and TV recognitions. Be sure to check the Chamber's calendar for upcoming events.

Jim Grant, ALA GM: The ALA has been going through a CEQA process for a general lake management plan. Grant discussed lake level and temperature.

John Conner, the Tudor House: Connor mentioned that their success has created traffic and parking issues. He suggested we invite Mountain Transit to the next MAC meeting to discuss these issues.

Donny Mahoney, SBC Sheriff: Mahoney discussed the recent issue regarding mannequins with names and bulls eyes. 30 individuals have been arrested. He discussed crime stats and will give a report at the next MAC meeting.

Mark Barr, Cal Fire: Fire season is coming soon. Cal Fire is hiring additional firefighters.

Tel Preszler, CHP: Lt. Preszler discussed a fundraiser for the Garcia family. Their son recently passed away from leukemia and they are in need of community assistance.
