**Mountain Transit:** Jesse Smith introduced himself and gave an update on the Trolley.

**SB County Fire:** Kat Opliger introduced the new Battalion Chief Jack De Jong. He gave some background on himself. He discussed how the fires in the State are affecting local staffing levels. All County fire stations are fully staffed.

**Cal Fire:** Captain Radinsky? Introduced himself. Discussed fires they are fighting all over the state. Discussed several fuels reduction projects. Last several months there have been several serious automobile accidents.

**US Forest Service:** Brian Grant discussed fire restrictions. There have been a few fires related to lightning strikes. After putting them out they check for 3 days after in case of flare ups. Deer Lick Station is open. Lots of activities for kids and families.

**Lake Arrowhead Communities Chamber of Commerce:** Robin Bull discussed upcoming Governmental Affairs Committee, the Brewfest coming up this weekend, a ribbon cutting at the Lake Gregory Community Center for a new church. Largest event of the year, the Home Tour, is coming up in September. She also discussed the County / Lake Arrowhead tourism program.

**Rim Rec & Park District:** Carly Corn discussed upcoming events including National Night Out, Run through the Pines, and their fall and winter programs. Dr. Bialecki mentioned the Blue Jay Jazz Festival.

**Rim of the World Association of Realtors:** Carol Banner shared that the market is steady and strong.

**CHP:** Lt. Coronado gave condolences regarding fire fighter fatalities. He discussed parking and other enforcement actions. He discussed the recent fire affecting hwy 38. Labor Day weekend the CHP will have maximum enforcement in the mountains. He will be attending the National Night Out event at the Lake Gregory Community Center. He also announced that he has been promoted to Captain and reassigned to Sacramento. He answered severe questions from the audience.

**Citizens on Patrol:** David Caine mentioned they are still recruiting for volunteers.

**6.0 Supervisor's Report:** Murray discussed the Lake Gregory community meeting, traffic impacts from trucks starting next week, the Edison community meeting, Joint MAC meeting in September, and updates on projects in the Lake Arrowhead area.

Air traffic over Lake Arrowhead: David Caine discussed that Quiet Skies Lake Arrowhead (QSLA) will be forming as a 501c Non Profit Corporation. Tony St. John discussed the reorganization plan. The new group will be called Friends of Lake Arrowhead Mountain Communities.
