Call Fire: Jeff Veik introduced Captain Joe Pidgeon who is the defensible space program administrator. Hazzard tree removal: Cal Fire removed 38 hazard trees along Old Mill and Hwy 138. There are still more to go. They must be sensitive to environmental issues. He discussed the defensible space program.

The basin will be located on property purchased from Church of the Woods, which is located at the headwaters to Little Bear Creek. EIR comment period will end in June.
