1.0 Call to Order & Pledge of Allegiance

The meeting was called to order by Chair Voni Saxbury at 6:01 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

3.0 Community Input: Topics discussed included providing street lights at specific locations around the mountain for safety purposes.

4.0 Special Presentation: Jerome "Punch" Ringhofer shared his concerns with Hwy 138 between Crestline and Pilot Rock Camp. The route is used for detours when the Cajon Pass is closed for weather or fire. Big rigs often travel this route and create road closures due to jack-knifing on the sharp turns. He recommends prohibiting big rig traffic on this route. Terri Kasinga from Cal Trans was in attendance to discuss their perspective on this issue.

5.0 Supervisor's Report: Murray introduced Supervisor Rutherford's new Chief of Staff Phil Paule. He discussed the Crest Forest MAC, the Supervisor participating in the Blue Jay Parade, and the Supervisor's annual Christmas Open House. All are invited and encouraged to bring an unwrapped gift or gift card for a toy drive.

Polly Sauer, Lake Arrowhead Communities Chamber of Commerce: Polly discussed the bonfires in Crestline and Lake Arrowhead, and the opening of Sky Park. She also discussed some upcoming events including the Taste of Lake Arrowhead.

Hugh Bialecki, Rim of the World Recreation & Park District: Bialecki discussed the upcoming focus group. He also announced the Rim Rec would be participating in the Blue Jay Parade.

Vikki Goodglick, Lake Arrowhead Village: Goodglick announced they have several new tenants including a gym. The Village will also be participating in the parade. She also encouraged people to attend the bonfire scheduled for next Monday.

Roberta Rindenow, Arrowhead Lake Association: Rindenow discussed the benefits of membership in the ALA. She also shared that they did a shoreline clean-up. There is also a YouTube video of the ALA stocking the lake with trout.

Shane Massoud, Senator Morell's office: Massoud discussed the "Patriots of the Past, Present, and Future." They are looking for nominations. He passed out a flier that included nomination information.

Mark Barr, Cal Fire: Barr discussed the upcoming wind event. They will have extra staffing ready if necessary. Discussed recent lightening fires and the importance of careful ash disposal. Soak in water for 24 hours.
