ONTARIO, California- San Bernardino County Fourth District Supervisor Curt Hagman joined his colleagues at the Ontario International Airport Authority to announce new air service between Nanchang, capital city of Jiangxi Province China and Ontario International Airport (ONT).

This flight expansion will support Ontario's rapid growth and aggressive strategy to give travelers more reasons to select Ontario Airport."
