HAGMAN RE-APPOINTS ELDONA ARNS TO SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY TRAILS COMMITTEE

SAN BERNARDINO, CA – Supervisor Curt Hagman announced the appointment of Eldona Reasoner Arns to the San Bernardino County Trails Committee. The Board of Supervisors unanimously voted to confirm the appointment, Tuesday morning, during their regularly scheduled meeting.

Eldona Arns, of Chino Hills, has been a member of the County Trail Committee since its formation. She currently serves as the Vice President of the Arabian Horse Association of Southern California. Eldona is also an active member of the McCoy Equestrian Center Committee and has served as a past member of the Trail Committee of Chino Hills.

Supervisor Hagman commented, "Eldona's interest in trails stems from her desire to provide as much access as possible to pedestrians, bicyclers, and horsemen. She is the perfect choice for the Trails Committee."

San Bernardino County Trails is responsible for making recommendations to the Advisory Commission and the Regional Parks Division pertaining to the development of a well-balanced trail system; recommend a system of mitigating measures to ensure that the location of trails will be compatible with and sensitive to other authorized land uses (e.g. wildlife corridors, wetlands and points of historical significance).

The San Bernardino County Trails Committee is comprised of 5 members. Commissioners are appointed by the Board of Supervisors and serve a total of four years.

Supervisor Curt Hagman was elected in November 2014 to represent the Fourth District, which includes the cities of Chino, Chino Hills, Ontario, Montclair and Upland (partial).
