HAGMAN APPOINTS JENNIFER SPENCE CARPENTER TO BEHAVIORAL HEALTH COMMISSION

SAN BERNARDINO, CA – Supervisor Curt Hagman announced, the appointment of Jennifer Spence Carpenter to the Behavioral Health Commission. The Board of Supervisors unanimously voted to confirm the appointment, Tuesday morning, during their regularly scheduled meeting.

Jennifer Spence Carpenter, of Chino, has 17 years of experience in the mental health field in Hacienda La Puente Unified School District (HLPUSD) as a Counselor to students and their families. Carpenter has a BS in Psychology and an MA in Marriage and Family Child Counseling (now Marriage & Family Therapy).

Supervisor Hagman commented, "Jen is a professional in the field and her expertise will allow her to serve the San Bernardino County community. Her desire to help people in the field of mental health is innate and she has done a superb job in helping others obtain services, resources and information through her work. "

The Behavioral Health Commission serves to advise the Board of Supervisors and the Director of Behavioral Health on aspects of local mental health programs; evaluate community mental health needs, services and facilities; and approve procedures for citizen and professional involvement in the planning process.

The Behavioral Health Commission is comprised of 16 members, 15 of which are appointed by the Board of Supervisors. Commissioners serve a total of three years.

Supervisor Curt Hagman was elected in November 2014 to represent the Fourth District, which includes the cities of Chino, Chino Hills, Ontario, Montclair and Upland (partial).
